

SKIP HIRE - TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Hire is for:-
 - a) NON-INERT MATERIALS
Commercial waste (excluding animal by-products), plastics, garden refuse (leaves, hedge cuttings, trees etc.)
 - or
 - b) INERT MATERIALS
Builders rubble, soil, excavations, concrete, brick, slate, tiles, clay-ware, pottery, china, glass, etc.
2. No mixed loads (i.e. do not mix Inert and Non-Inert Materials), as this will result in an increased charge.
3. No Hazardous materials – ASBESTOS, TYRES, CHEMICALS, TV/COMPUTER MONITORS, FRIDGE/FRIDGE FREEZERS, GAS BOTTLES, PAINT, OIL (HAZARDOUS WASTE) etc.
4. On no account will a skip be removed if it is overfilled or contains hazardous materials. Any charges in the removal of such items will be the responsibility of the hirer.
5. Hirers will be liable for the extra cost of disposal if the skips are subsequently found to contain a mixed load or hazardous material.
6. Charges for hire of skips are for up to five working days including delivery and collection and include VAT. Extra days are charged per day plus VAT.
7. All chain lift skips must be filled to stated level only – all overloaded skips will incur a penalty charge.
8. Penalty charge for overloaded chain lift skips is £45.00 + VAT. Photographic evidence will be collected to support this charge. There will be no exceptions.
9. Skips will be collected as soon as practicable after the fifth day unless an alternative arrangement was made at the time of booking.
10. Any arrangements agreed with the driver on site must be confirmed with the office on 0161 474 5621.
11. If any skip is emptied and returned it will be charged as a second hire at the full rate.
12. It is the hirer's responsibility to provide the information required to obtain a permit when the skip is to be placed on the highway.
13. If the skip is to be placed on private land the hirer or his agent must be on site at the time of delivery.
14. It is the hirer's responsibility to ensure that the signs and cones are placed around the skip at all times and the lamps are lit during the hours of the darkness, when a skip is placed on the highway.
15. Should Waste Solutions SK personnel be called upon to put out cones, signs and lamps, there will be additional charges for each occasion.
16. Great care must be exercised by the hirer when removing a tailgate from a skip for access where opening doors have not been provided.
17. All skips to be paid for in advance prior to delivery.
18. Any misuse of the skip may lead to refusal of hires in the future.
19. Waste Solutions SK reserve the right to refuse a skip order if it has reason to believe these terms and conditions will not be adhered to.
20. Skips cancelled with 24 hours of delivery may be subject to a cancellation fee unless prior arrangements have been made.
21. All skips being delivered require a person on site to instruct the driver of exact skip location. In the case of no one being available on site and the skip being returned to depot undelivered the hirer shall be liable for the delivery costs incurred.
22. Because of the risk of damage to pavements and driveway surfaces, skips at residential properties will only be placed on the highway. If however, a disclaimer is received from the hirer before delivery indemnifying the organisation, skips will be placed on driveways at the discretion of the driver. There must be at least a 10ft opening width. Please note these are roll on/roll off skips which require maximum room to manoeuvre.
23. Skips are placed on private property, car parks, school and industrial units etc., only at the hirer's request and risk. Waste Solutions accept no responsibility for any damage caused when carrying out such requests.
24. Fires in skips are not permitted. The hirer will be liable for repair costs if skips are subject to fire damage.
25. The hirer is responsible for any damage, however caused, to skips required to be left overnight.
